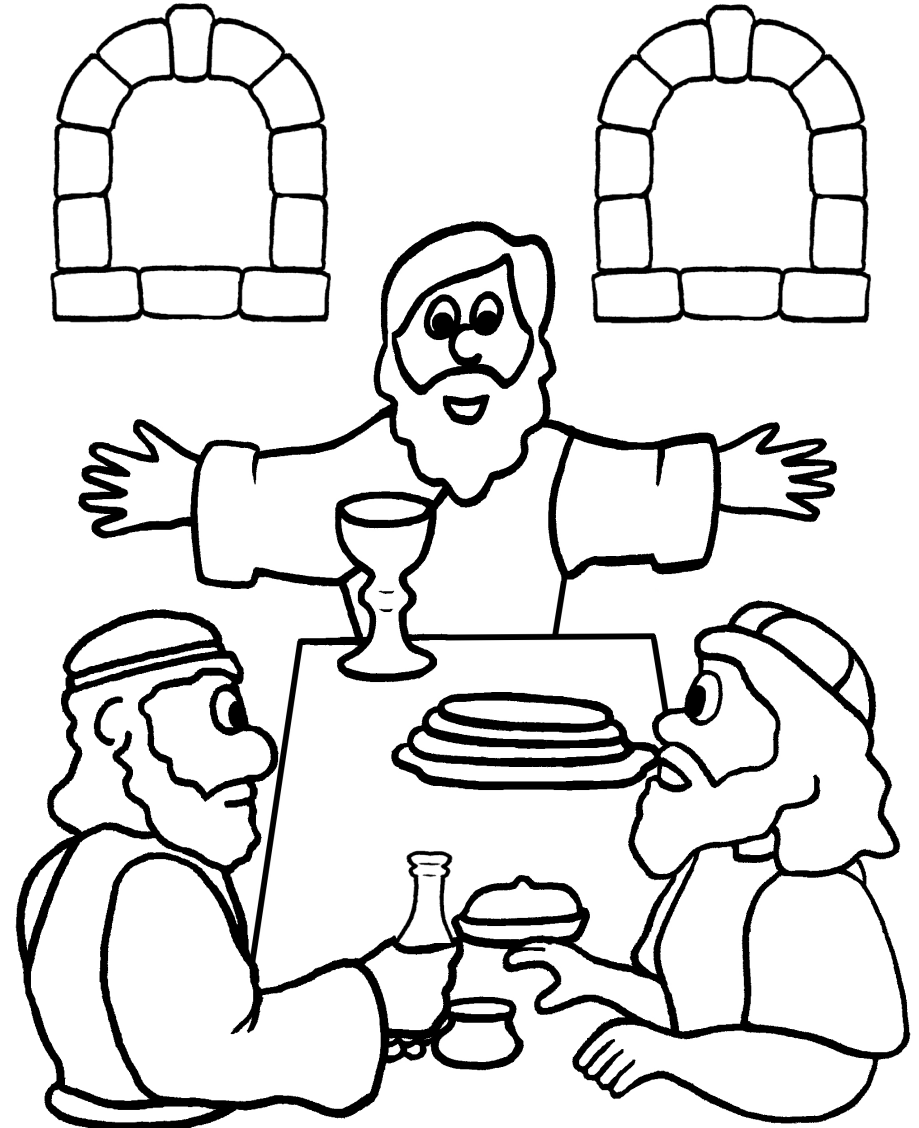

And **likewise** the cup after they had **eaten**, saying, "This cup that is **poured out** for you is the **new covenant** in my **blood**."
