






The disciples went to an upper room to get things ready for Passover.

Fish: Today, some Jewish people serve a chopped fish dish called "Gefilte fish" at their Passover meal.



Bitter herbs: Parsley, or a vegetable dipped in salt water, is often on the table. The water reminds lews of their tears.



Wine: This drink, made from grapes, is shared while special prayers are said.



Lamb: Some people have lamb on the table, as a reminder of when God saved the Jewish people using a Passover lamb.



Matzoh: This flat bread is made without yeast. It reminds the Jewish people of their escape from Egypt, long ago.

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
